SCHOOLMESSENGER:

SchoolMessenger will be used again this year to send parent notifications, it can be accessed by logging into PowerSchool and click in the half box with the arrow (²) in the upper right corner of your PowerSchool page.

FEES

Fees can be waived/reduced by completing the Free/Reduced application and returning/submitting before **October 4th, 2024**. Fees can be paid online using our new fee system EduTrakConnect or by dropping off or mailing a check to the school.
